For those at risk of falling and injuring themselves, the Tunstall fall detector identifies when the user falls and sends an automatic alarm call for help.

For cerebral palsy clients who experience seizures, the Tunstall nocturnal epilepsy sensor can be placed on their mattress to detect tonic-clonic seizures or hyperventilation, alerting the response centre, a carer or even someone in the next room.

These solutions can be used to keep someone living with cerebral palsy safe, empowered and independent in their own home.

Telecare is also suitable for people living in shared or supported housing providing protection for the residents and their physical environment.

Flood detectors can be installed to detect overflowing baths or sinks and smoke detectors for pots and pans boiling dry.

Bed occupancy sensors can determine if someone has gotten out of bed and not returned, suggesting a fall, or if they have failed to get out of bed at all.

All of these sensors can be programmed to go to the onsite carer, immediately alerting them of potentially hazardous situations.
